WHO MAY APPLY: **ZONE 1-2**

**ZONE 1.** On Board AK ARNG Only (**Must have held current position for minimum of 18 months**)

**ZONE 2.** All Alaska Army National Guard Members

All applications will be accepted, however, first consideration will be given to current on-board AGR members (Zone 1) of the AK ARNG/ANG. Applicants must meet Chapter 3 physical standards IAW NGR 40-501 and AR 40-501. Soldiers must meet initial eligibility requirements of AR 135-18, Table 2-1.

**DUTIES:** Develops all source intelligence products through the fusion data accumulated from maps and intelligence derived from a variety of sources. Makes reliability assessments of information received through comparison with previously evaluated information on hand. Maintains close liaison with other staff elements and specialized intelligence activities to include counterintelligence, imagery interpretation, interrogation, and language interpretation units. Ensures compliance with computer interface and operating procedures, concepts, and principles as applied to ADP in the development and maintenance of intelligence data base. Develops and maintains situation maps, overlays, and reports to provide complete and accurate intelligence information to users. Establishes and maintains files as a basis for information to support commander's decisions. Maintains current information concerning friendly and enemy forces to include identification, disposition, personalities, combat efficiency, and history. Develops and prepares enemy vulnerability studies and evaluates their significance for use in predicting probable enemy courses of action in terms of disposition, capabilities, and intentions. Supervises intelligence production operations and intelligence surveillance and reconnaissance synchronization functions. **Additional duties as required by the selecting supervisor.**

#### **SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT CRITERIA:**

- Be a SGT (E-5) or above (not waiver able) and completed 35F MOS producing school.
- Be a current 350F Warrant Officer (WO1 – WO2)
- Possess a Top Secret Clearance based on a **Single Scope Background Investigation** (SSBI)

**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** Must be or eligible to become a member of the Alaska Army National Guard. Must be able to serve at least 3 years on active military status prior to soldier's mandatory removal date, or completing 18 years of active Federal Service. In the grade of CW2 must have completed a warrant officer basic course or received MOS proponent equivalent credit. In the grade of CW3, or above, must have completed a warrant officer advanced course or received MOS proponent equivalent credit. Must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-50. When appropriate, the soldier must also meet the medical fitness standards for flying duty per AR 40-501, chapter 4, or the medical fitness standards for miscellaneous purposes per AR 40-501, chapter 5. Must not be a candidate for an elective office, hold a civil office, or are engaged in partisan political activities. Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions. Applicants who voluntarily separate from the AGR program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from date of separation without an NGB waiver. Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal

military retired or retainer pay or Federal civil service annuities and not be eligible for immediate Federal civil service annuities. Individuals who voluntarily resign from the AGR program in lieu of mandatory or involuntary separation action are not eligible to reenter the program. Individuals who have been separated from other military services for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service are not eligible to enter the AGR program. Must be eligible to receive an Alaska Driver's License.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Interested applicants who meet the eligibility requirements listed above may apply by submitting the below listed documents to the **Alaska National Guard, Human Resources Office (HRO), Bldg 49000, Room D-209, P.O. Box 5800, Ft Richardson, AK 99505-5800**. Applicants must type or print in legible dark ink and SIGN AND DATE each application. Packets received without a signed and dated NGB Form 34-1 will result in non-consideration and the application will *not* be forwarded to the selecting supervisor. Applicants may include copies of their Certificates of Training that may be applicable to the position you are applying for but **MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE BELOW LISTED DOCUMENTS.** If the required documents/forms are not submitted with the application package, a letter of explanation must be provided. **Incomplete application packages received will not be forwarded or considered.**

**INSTRUCTIONS TO COMMANDERS/SUPERVISORS:** This position vacancy announcement will be given the broadest possible dissemination. A copy of this announcement will be posted on your unit/activity bulletin board. Selecting supervisor will contact qualified applicants for interviews. After the Human Resources Officer (HRO) approves the selection package, the HRO office will send a notification letter to all applicants of their selection/non-selection. The selection of an applicant is not final until the individual has been notified by the HRO-AGR. After the selecting supervisor makes a selection, the "routing" of the selection package begins and ends with HRO.
