SUBJECT: Guidance for Higher Risk for Serious Illness

1. References:

2. In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and 0MB memorandum M-20-16, all members of the Alaska Organized Militia (AKOM), to include Title 5 federal employees, Title 32 dual status technicians, or members on State Active Duty (StAD) infected with, or at higher risk for serious illness from COVID-19, are restricted from accessing facilities on federal installations.

3. This policy is based on the significant health risks to employees if they are traveling to and performing work at their normal worksite. The CDC identified populations include, older adults (65 and older), and individuals who have chronic health conditions such as high blood pressure, heart disease, diabetes, lung disease or compromised immune systems. 4. Employees that fall into this category will comply with current telework and leave guidance.
