



**REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**All candidates reporting for in-processing must arrive at the designated location according to the dates, times and information indicated below.**

All candidates must arrive with documentation of:

- 1) Proof of a negative test (completed within 5 days of scheduled arrival)-**OR-**
- 2) Proof of a positive test in the last 90 days **AND** clearance; listing the quarantine dates and release date **AND** be fever free without medication

Youth are picked up outside baggage claim by AMYA staff and transported to campus. **Flights will be made for Platoon 1 (female youth) for January 20<sup>th</sup> and Platoon 2 and 3 (males) for January 21<sup>st</sup>.** Dates may change dependent on flight schedules. If you have any issues or delays you will need to contact Ms. Conner or Mr. Schara- or -, if after hours, the TLC at 907-428-7325 or the Commandant at 907-428-7320. **Please make sure you have your photo ID and wear a face covering to report.**

**Parent Orientation:**

**Medication Reminder**

Medications are administered by the registered nurse or an authorized person for your cadet. If possible, medication prescriptions need to be supplied for the 6-month duration. Applicants are required to have at least a 30-day supply of needed medications and two months of refills (prescriptions). Medications to bring include any that your cadet is currently prescribed including asthma inhalers and EpiPens. For questions regarding prescriptions for controlled medications, please contact 907-428-7354. The preferred pharmacy for use is the Family Pharmacy located at 11432 Business Blvd #10, Eagle River, AK 99577, phone number (907) 694-7007.

### **School Withdrawal Requirements**

It is the responsibility of each candidate to ensure that they have withdrawn from any school they are currently enrolled in prior to attending the Academy. Upon withdrawing from school, please obtain a withdrawal slip. **Youth may stay enrolled in their school up until the start of the AMYA cycle.**

### **Mentor Requirement:**

All candidates for admission to the ChalleNGe program must have provided a completed mentor application and/or the name and contact information for a prospective mentor. Mentor application or prospective mentor information must be provided on or before the start date of the class.

**A parent and mentor letter will be provided via email that will contain all the important dates/times and contact information which will be based on the assigned platoon. These letters will also be posted online and available upon report.**

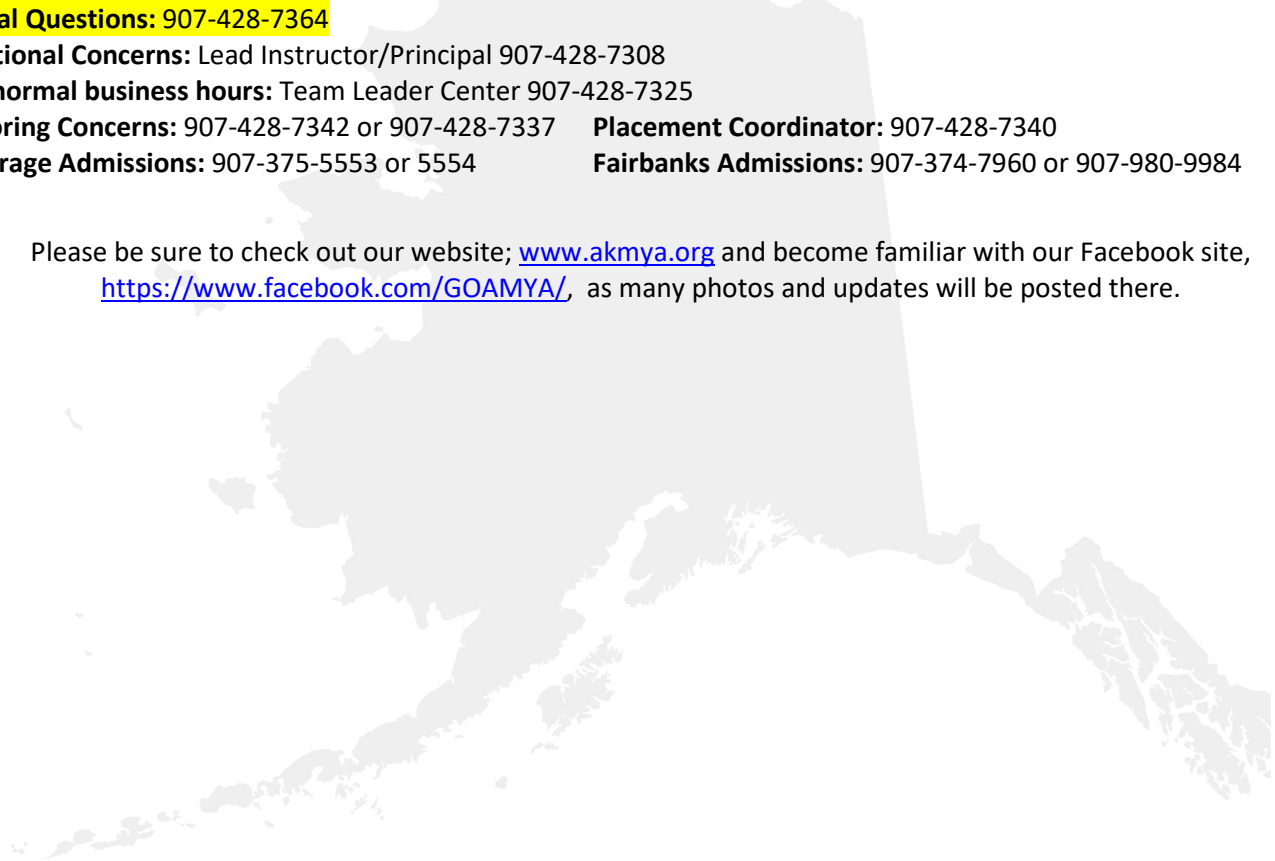

### **PACKING LIST: Clothing, Personal & Academic Items**

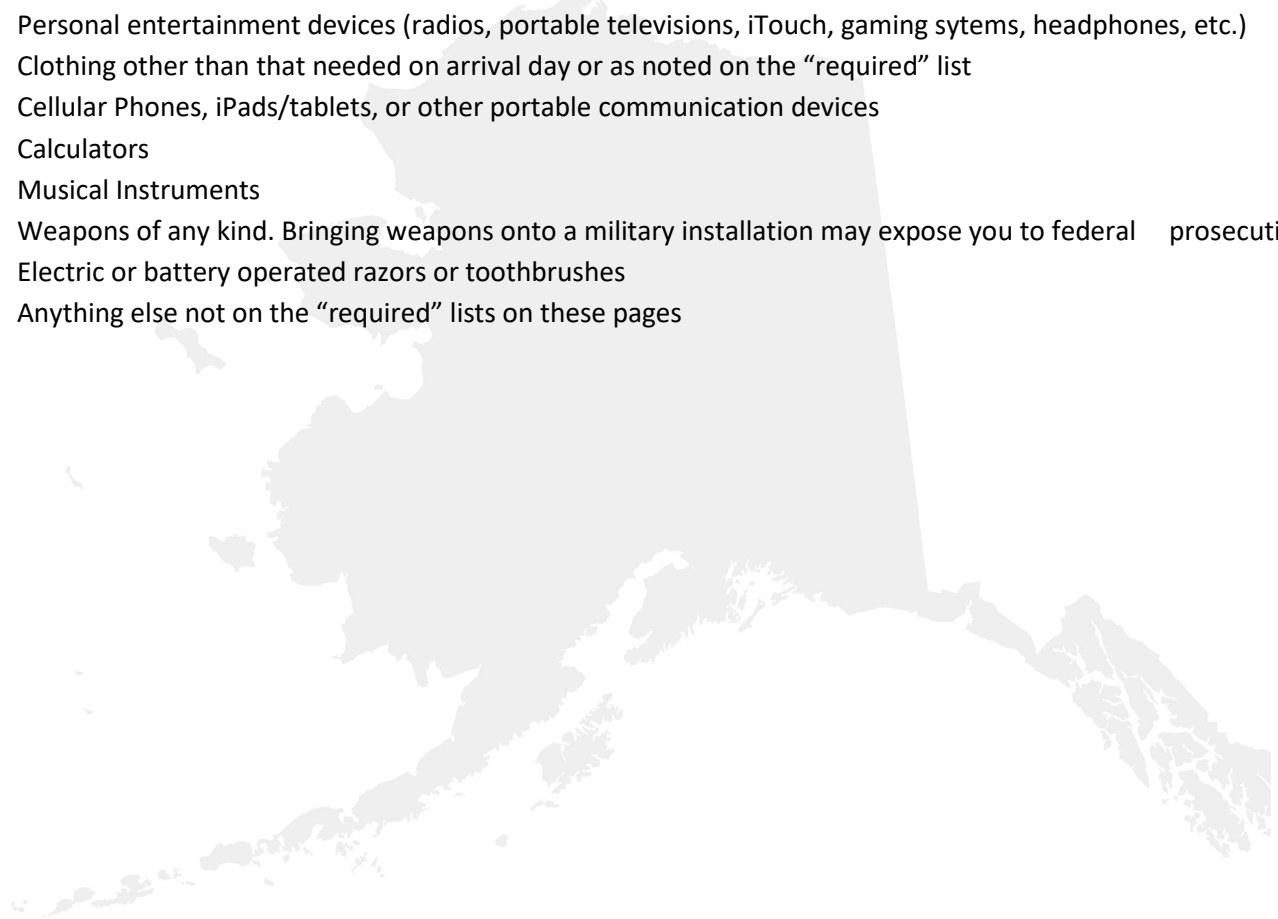
Each AMYA Challenge Program candidate should bring the noted clothing and personal items to In-processing at the date and time prescribed for his/her class.

**Special Notes/General:** The following general notes provide overview or answers to frequently asked questions:

- Money is not desired, required nor recommended. Secure storage is not available until week 3 of the program.
- All personal products should be **unscented/low scent** due to our communal environment and the likelihood of a participant or staff member with allergies or other medical conditions .
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**Items NOT to bring:** The following items should not be brought to the Alaska Military Youth Academy. If brought, they will be boxed and placed in storage until the candidate/cadet graduates or otherwise leaves the program.

- \*\*\*NO MONEY\*\*\***
- Contact lenses
- Jewelry, including body jewelry
- Makeup or other hair care products or beauty aids except as noted on the “required” list
- Tweezers
- Wallets
- Personal Conveyances (automobiles, skates, skate boards, bikes, etc.)
- Personal entertainment devices (radios, portable televisions, iTouch, gaming systems, headphones, etc.)
- Clothing other than that needed on arrival day or as noted on the “required” list
- Cellular Phones, iPads/tablets, or other portable communication devices
- Calculators
- Musical Instruments
- Weapons of any kind. Bringing weapons onto a military installation may expose you to federal prosecution.
- Electric or battery operated razors or toothbrushes
- Anything else not on the “required” lists on these pages



## FEMALE PACKING LIST

- FACE MASKS:** For the disposable masks, that is about 35. For cloth masks or washable face coverings, that will be about 6-10. Note: if you can't find or afford masks, we will provide them to all candidates.
- Hair Brush** with rounded handle-1 each
- Comb** with rounded handle-1 each
- Snap clips for hair:** color to match your natural hair color-1 pack
- Elastic bands for hair,** color to match your natural hair color-1 pack
- Bobby Pins:** color to match your natural hair color, different sizes allowed-1 pack
- Hair styling gel and/or Oil Moisturizer Lotion:** plain no glitter or shine style-1 each
- Anti-perspirant/Deodorant:** unscented or baby powder scent only, no aerosols, No perfume or floral scents-1 each
- Razors/blades:** No electric or battery operated razors. Disposable razors are acceptable.
- Shaving cream/gel:** unscented/low scent, no perfume or floral scents-1 each
- Shampoo/Conditioner:** unscented/low scent, i.e. Tre'seme/Pantene/anti dandruff-1 each
- Body wash or Bar soap and soap container:** unscented-1 each
- White bath towels:** white only, standard size not beach towel size-3 each
- White wash cloths:** white only-3 each
- Hand Lotion:** Fragrance free/unscented/low scent (no larger than 11.8 oz.)-1 each
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste (5.8 oz. tube), and toothbrush holder:** 1 each
- Squeeze tube Carmex:** plain, not flavored/not "shimmer"-1 each
- Photo Identification Card** (Military Dependent or State ID)
- 1st class Stamps/Forever Stamps:** 1-2 book(s)
- Envelopes:** letter mailing envelopes (#10 size)-1 box
- 2 pair of glasses and prescription:** if needed

### Optional Items

- Black boot polish kit:** wax only NO cream or liquid authorized (i.e. Kiwi/Lincoln/Penguin)
- Watch** - Nonmetal band only - low value, black
- Foot powder (4-12 oz.):** Desenex, Gold Bond, etc. (no baby powder)
- Acne cream/face wash:** **CANNOT** contain alcohol- (optional)
- Sunscreen Lotion:** Rub on (NO Spray), Clear Drying (8-10 ounces)
- Lint Roller Pack**-3 Pack or 1 Large Roller
