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Holiday Pass: Holiday Pass will be off campus beginning on Saturday, December 22nd to Wednesday, December 26th. Cadets who cannot go home for the pass or do not have family that can come to Anchorage, will remain on campus with staff. Pick up will be on 12/22 at 9am at the AMYA Muldoon Recruiting office location (1251 Muldoon Rd., Space 114). Cadets must be returned by 6 pm on 12/26 at the JBER- Richardson Ft. Richardson/Arctic Valley gate. If your cadet will be flying home for this pass, please coordinate with your cadet's platoon leader and provide a copy of the itinerary at least two weeks before pass date. Academic Section Information

Reminder: It is the responsibility of the prospective Cadet and their family to ensure that AMYA has an updated transcript. It should note the course title and credits earned to date. Additionally, prospective Cadets and family should retain copies of these documents and understand the graduation requirements for the State of Alaska, as well as what the transcript reflects in relation to the graduation requirements. For your information, please note the information below on possible secondary school credits offered by the Academy for successful completion of classes.

Mathematics: 1.0 credit

Science: 1.0 credit

Social Studies: 1.0 credit

English: 1.0 credit

Integrated Studies (includes: EverFi Financial Literacy, Keyboarding, Radius Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (S.T.E.M.) Program curriculum and P.L.A.T.O. credit recovery as assigned) .5 credit (for Financial Literacy)

Physical Fitness: 1.0 credit

Wilderness Training: 0.5 credit

Life Coping: 1.0 credit

Industrial Arts: 0.5 credit

*Additional credits beyond .5 may be earned in Integrated Studies depending on credit recovery needs/offering.

Standard Credits Available: 7.5

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Medical Section Information

Health Insurance Requirements: Uninsured or under-insured AMYA Participants may qualify for Denali Care (Medicaid) or Denali Kid Care while in the program and all participants are encouraged to apply. Medical care costs are the responsibility of the parent or guardian of each participant so it is critical that medical insurance (including Denali Kid Care) be kept current and active during the entire program. If your child is covered by Denali Kid Care, Medicaid, Tricare, or any other insurance, please make sure these policies are maintained and updated as required.

AMYA Medical Staff will need **copies of any insurance cards** you may have in order **to facilitate appropriate billing including any co-pays for medications/refills. Co-pays are the responsibility of Parents/Guardians regardless of where the medications are refilled.**

AMYA participants who qualify for benefits thru Alaska Native Medical Center and/or Tricare must be registered in Anchorage to utilize these benefits. If you live outside the Anchorage area, please contact the appropriate administrative office of your insurance provider to “transfer” your child’s care to the Anchorage area. This can be done by using the AMYA address at JBER as their temporary residence address.

Final Drill and Ceremony Competition and Visitation: Saturday, February 16th, with the ceremony beginning at 12pm with family visitation immediately after until 4pm. The location is TBD. This competition and visitation is for immediate family (parents/guardians, grandparents, and siblings) and mentors only.
