AREAS OF CONSIDERATION

(Must have held current duty position for a minimum of 18 months)
Applicants must meet Chapter 3 physical standards IAW NGR 40-501 and AR 40-501. Initial eligibility requirements IAW AR 135-18, Table 2-1

MAJOR DUTIES MAY INCLUDE

- Travel with Command Senior Enlisted (C-SEL) to selected events as required
- Work on behalf of the C-SEL as an adjunct to communicate with AKNG SEL's in the ARNG and ANG.
- Develop special projects to enhance the health, welfare, and quality of life for AKNG Soldiers and Airmen
- Manage and foster relationships with SNCO's and NCO's from all AKNG units on behalf of the AKNG C-SEL
- provide administrative support to C-SEL and Office of The Adjutant General
 - Mail/Email
 - Business Cards
 - Official biography and photo management
 - Coins
 - Gifts
- Prepare and arrange trip itineraries; Manage DTS for C-SEL
- Provide assistance to the TAG's Aide de Camp
- Meet and host the C-SEL's distinguished guest
- Schedule and track C-SEL Senior Leader Development Courses (through ANG SELMO and ARNG)
- Prepare and organize schedules, activities, and calendars
- Coordinate protocol activities
- Provide operator maintenance of government vehicles and driving duties as required
- Perform additional duties as required

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- SECURITY CLEARANCE – **Secret**
- Physical Demands Rating – Moderately heavy
- Approval of Exceptional Family Member Program is required
- No pattern of undesirable behavior as evidenced by civil and military records
- No record of civilian conviction within the last 2 years other than minor traffic offenses
- No record of convictions by court martial
- No record of conviction by special or general courts-martial or civilian courts of offenses listed in AR 27-10 (Military Justice), chapter 24 or otherwise required to register as a sexual offender under AR 27-10, chapter 24
- Passing Army Physical Fitness Test and professional appearance in uniform
- Must possess a valid state motor vehicle operator license
- Complete or enrollment with positive progression in Enlisted PME commensurate with current grade
- **Approval of Command Sponsorship through the Exceptional Family Member Program is Required**
- **Must be willing to reside in (relocate to) and work at JBER-Richardson, AK**

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT CRITERIA

- **LENGTH OF TOUR IS LIMITED TO 12-18 MONTHS ONLY**
- Applicant must be endorsed through unit Chain of Command
- Upon selection additional medical verification will be required prior to start of AGR tour

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

Must be or be eligible to become a member of the Alaska Army National Guard	Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions	Must not be a candidate for an elective office, hold a civil office, or are engaged in partisan political activities
Applicants not currently serving on an AGR Tour must be able to serve at least 3 years in the AGR program prior to completing 18 years Active Federal Service (AFS) (any combination of Active Duty, Active Duty Special Work, Annual Training, and/or AGR program for a total of 18 years), or the date of mandatory removal	Individuals who voluntarily resign from the AGR program in lieu of mandatory or involuntary separation action are not eligible to reenter the program without and NGB waiver Applicants who voluntarily separated/resign from the AGR program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from date of separation	If a selectee does not possess the advertised MOS, he/she must complete the required training/assignment criteria within 12 months of being assigned to the position. Failure to do so may result in immediate termination. Extension past 12-months will only be considered if the delay is through no fault of the selectee
Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal military retired or retainer pay or Federal civil service annuities and not be eligible for immediate Federal civil service annuities	Individuals who have been separated from other military services for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service are not eligible to enter the AGR program without an approved waiver (if applicable)	An applicant's military grade cannot exceed the maximum military authorized grade on the UMR for the AGR position. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested applicants who meet the eligibility criteria listed in this announcement may apply by submitting the below listed documents to AKNG-Apply@mail.mil. Hard copy applications will **NOT** be accepted. All applications must be typed or printed in legible dark ink and must be signed and dated. **Applications received with an unsigned NGB 34-1 will not be forwarded for consideration.** Complete applications must be received in HRO-AGR office **no later than 2359 of the closing date.** Applicants may include copies of training certificates or any documentation that may be applicable to the position they are applying for but the **complete application package must include all documents listed below.** *Items are required by the Human Resource Office to determine qualifications.* If the requested documents are not submitted, a letter of explanation must be included. **Incomplete packages will not be considered for the position vacancy.**

Packet must be in the following order:

1. Cover Letter (Please include personal and military email)

3. Last five Enlisted Evaluation Report (NCOER)
4. Certified copy of Enlisted Record Brief (ERB)
5. DA photograph in military uniform (taken within the last 24 months)
6. Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) Report from MEDPROS with last Physical Health Assessment (PHA) within 12 months. (*It is important that you print the report, not the webpage screen)
7. DA Form 705 dated May 2010, current within 6 months if AGR and FTNGD-OS,
8. DA Form 5500/550, current within 6 months if AGR and FTNGD-OS (if applicable)

After the Human Resources Officer (HRO) approves the selection package, the HRO office will send a notification letter to all applicants of their selection/non-selection. The selection of an applicant is not final until the individual has been notified by the HRO-AGR. After the selecting supervisor makes a selection, the "routing" of the selection package begins and ends with HRO.
