

# SPILL CONTINGENCY PLAN

**CAN YOU SAFELY CONTROL AND CLEAN UP WITH THE MATERIALS AND PERSONNEL YOU HAVE ON HAND?**

**YES**

Controlled Release



**Turn off ignition sources** and avoid vapors.



**Put on PPE.** Gloves and goggles can be found in spill kits.



**Stop the flow.** Close valves, upright container, or create a berm with boom/dirt/snow.



**Protect storm drains.**



**Clean the spill area.** Use absorbents, pads, and other materials to soak up spill.



**Prep for disposal.** Place all used sorbent, snow, soil, and materials into drum or bags using **NON-SPARKING** tools.



**Label waste container(s).**

Example:

JP8 Spill Residue  
10/17/25



**REPORT!**



**NO**

Uncontrolled Release



**Turn off ignition sources** and avoid vapors.



**Protect drains if possible.**



**Evacuate if necessary.**



**Report.**



## SPILL NOTIFICATION CHAIN

**Do not leave only a voice mail!**

**Notification is not complete until speaking with a person.**

**ALL spills of ANY size must be reported to Environmental Section.**



**During Non-Duty Hours Call 911 when:**

- MORE than 55 gallons of POL hits the ground
- POL or hazardous waste/material goes into floor drains or sewage system
- ANY hazardous substance spill, other than POL, is released
- ANY amount of POL or hazardous waste/material goes into a body of water
- The spill presents a fire, safety, or health risk

MAKE SURE YOU STATE "NON-EMERGENCY" IF ASSISTANCE ISN'T NEEDED TO CLEAN UP THE SPILL
